## **DETAILED TENDER CALL NOTICE**

### **1. Since this is a special nature of work, criteria have been fixed as follows:**

- i. Bidders should have successfully completed at least one similar project of Aquarium in any Govt. (State/Central), Govt. undertaking Organization during last 3 financial years. Completion certificate/Work order to be enclosed.
- ii. Minimum Annual turnover of the bidder should be 84.27 Lakh & above during last 5 years which is to be certified by a qualified Chartered Accountant.
- iii. The bidder must submit the documents of GSTIN, PAN, EPF Registration & ESI registration certificate, Affidavit, undertaking regarding No-relationship certificate which are mandatory.

### **2. Instructions to the Bidders.**

**The tender will be in two-bid system: Envelope-1 (Technical Bid) and Envelope-2 (Financial Bid).**

- a. **Envelope-1** will contain the following documents:
- b. Signed copy of the original tender documents together with original purchase receipt of the tender documents or original DD.
- c. Self attested Copies of all documents pertaining (Eligibility Criteria) as mentioned herein.
- d. Copies of all documents pertaining (Prequalification Criteria) as mentioned herein. Basing on the eligibility criteria a bid evaluation report will be prepared and only Financial bids of the qualified bidders will be opened.
- e. **Envelope-2** Financial Bid: The bidders should put their **percentage rate** (Quoted rate will be considered up to two decimal only)
- f. The outer envelope must be clearly marked the following:  
Name of the Project: "**Maintenance of Aquarium at Odisha State Maritime Museum, Jobra, Cuttack for one year**" The outer sealed envelope (Master Envelope) shall include two separate parts each clearly marked as "Technical Bid" and "Financial Bid".

- g. The technical bid should demonstrate the applicant's knowledge of the project requirements, understanding of the requisite, terms and references and capability to carry them out. Provision of the requested information in full must be set forth in the following sequence:-
- h. Background of the organization and experience of the firm in similar projects for the purpose of executing this project–Annexure-I
- i. Prequalification criteria and capability to execute works of such type to be given.
- j. As per details in Annexure-2 and will form a part of the evaluation process.
- k. Financial statement for the last 5 years in Annexure-3
- l. In order to obtain first hand information about the assignment the local conditions / constraints and concept of the entire project, it is advisable that the applicant visits the site to acquaint with the site conditions etc.
- m. In case of bidders in association with their dealers, the credentials of their dealer or themselves will hold good while evaluating the bids as per the prequalification criteria laid down in this tender document.
- n. The bidder will have to keep its offer valid for 90 days of the opening of the technical bids and in the case of withdrawal before that date the earnest money amount will be forfeited.
- o. The expenses on preparing the bids, visiting the site, attending the pre-submission meeting and negotiating the contract etc. will not be reimbursed.

#### **4. METHOD OF APPLYING**

- a) If the application is made by the individual it shall be signed above his full type written name and current address.
- b) If a proprietary firm makes the application, it shall be signed by the proprietor above his full typewritten name and the full name of his firm with its current address.
- c) If the application is made by a firm in partnership, it shall be signed by all the partners of the firm with their full name and current addresses or alternatively by a partner holding power of attorney for signing the documents, in which case, a certified copy of power of attorney shall be enclosed with the prequalification document. A certified copy of partnership deed and current address of all the partners of the firms shall also be enclosed with the prequalification document.
- d) If a limited company or a corporation makes the application, a duly authorized Person shall sign it.

## 5. SUBMISSION AND OPENING OF TENDER DOCUMENTS.

1. **The Superintending Engineer, Mahanadi South Division-I, Cuttack -cum-Member Secretary**, Odisha State Maritime Museum, Jobra, Cuttack on behalf of the Odisha State Maritime Museum Trust, Jobra, Cuttack invites off-line **Percentage rate tender** in the prescribed form to be eventually drawn in P.W.D. form P-1 from “Bidders should have successfully completed at least one similar project of Aquarium in any Govt. (State/Central), Govt. undertaking Organization during last 3 financial years. Completion certificate/Work order to be enclosed” for the work “**Maintenance of Aquarium at Odisha State Maritime Museum, Jobra, Cuttack for one year**”.
2. The bidder for participation by downloading the bidding document from the website will have to pay **Rs10,000/-(Rupees ten thousand)** only for each set through D.D drawn in any scheduled Bank. The Bid will be received from 10 AM of **28.12.2021 to 11.01.2022** up to 5.30 PM. Each set of bid document contains Technical Bid (Cover-I) and Financial Bid (Cover- II). **The cover-I bid will be opened offline on 12.01.2022 at 11.30 AM in the office of the Director, Odisha State Maritime Museum, Jobra, Cuttack in presence of the tenderer or their authorized agents.** The bids can only be opened by the pre-designated officials only after the opening time mentioned in the bid document. **Date, time and place of opening of Cover-II (price bid) shall be intimated separately to those tenderers who will be found eligible after evaluation of Cover-I (Technical bid). The intimation letter will be sent both through their email address and postal address.**
3. The value of the work tendered for is **Rs.56.18 Lakh**.
4. No tenderer will be permitted to furnish their tender in their own manuscript.
5. “**Bid Security Declaration**” is to be furnished as per F.D O.M No. FIN-COD-MISC.-0007-2019/8943/F dated 18.03.2021.
6. The maintenance work is to be carried out for 12 (twelve) **calendar months** from the date of work order.

The authority may extend the maintenance contract for maximum two more terms of 12 months each with same rate and terms & conditions subject to satisfactory performance of the agency and his/her willingness

7. The plans specifications and scope for the work can be seen in the office of the Superintending Engineer, Mahanadi South Division-I, Cuttack-cum-Member Secretary, Odisha State maritime Museum, Jobra, Cuttack during any working days.
8. The tenderers shall carefully study the tentative specifications applicable to the contract and all documents which form part of the agreement to be entered into by the accepted tenderer and detailed specifications which are available with the tender document or

with the Superintending Engineer, Mahanadi South Division-I, Cuttack-cum-Member Secretary, Odisha State maritime Museum, Jobra, Cuttack.

9. Complaint at a future date that plans and specifications have not been seen by the tenderers cannot be entertained.
10. The bidder must submit the documents in the GSTIN, PAN, EPF Registration & ESI registration certificate, Affidavit, undertaking regarding No-relationship certificate which are mandatory.
11. The bidder shall submit the documents in the designated locations of technical bid (Cover-I) and Financial bid (Cover-II). The 1st cover i.e. Cover-I (Technical bid) should contain GSTIN, PAN, EPF Registration & ESI registration certificate, Affidavit, undertaking declaring no relationship with Department officials & the 2nd cover i.e. Cover-II (Financial bid) should contain bill of quantities (BOQ) **with percentage quoted rate**.
12. Bidders desirous to hire machineries or equipments from outside the State are required to furnish 2% (Two percent) of the amount put to tender as bid security. Tender not accompanied with bid security and security for hired machineries as specified above shall be liable for rejection.
  - a) At the advertised time and place all bids received for the contract shall be opened by the officer inviting the tender (or any other officer authorized by him) in person, in the presence of their representatives who may choose to attend. No over writings shall be done but corrections where necessary shall be neatly scored out and rewritten prior to the submission of the tender.
  - b) At the time of opening of tenders, one additional officer/ Senior Engineer shall also be present invariably and sign each of the bids as witness. Bids shall be read out before the persons present and their Signatures obtained on each of the bids.
  - c) Attendance of the bidders or their authorized representatives shall be noted down in the register to be maintained for this purpose.
  - d) The officer opening the tenders would initial on each and every bids and the serial numbers of such bids with reference to total tenders noted on each bid as numerator/denominator. The initials shall be recorded on the page containing the financial offer.
  - e) Each and every correction or overwriting shall be initialed and the number of such corrections noted on the respective pages. The bidders are advised to properly seal the Tender document in their own interest.
  - f) Each bidder shall provide the name, residence and place of business of the person or persons giving the tender document and shall be signed by the bidder with his usual signature. When a partnership firm gives tender document then the full names of all partners shall be furnished. An attested copy of the constitution of the firm and the registered number of the firm shall be furnished. In such a case the tender document must be signed separately by each partner thereof or in the event of the absence of any partner must be signed on his behalf by a person holding a power of attorney authorizing him to be so. Tender documents by corporation shall be signed with the legal name of corporation followed by the name of the state of in-corporation



and by signature and by designation of the resident, secretary or other person authorized to bind it in the matter.

- g) The bidder shall also give the following information invariably on cover containing the Tender document:-
    - A. Name and address.
    - B. Amount of earnest money deposited and No. and date of the TDR/ F.D.R. / NSC.
  - h) Earnest money which has been deposited for a particular work will not ordinarily be adjusted towards the earnest money for another work.
  - i) The tender documents shall be opened at the time and place stated in the notice inviting tender by the officer issuing this NIT in the presence of the bidders or their duly authorized representatives who may choose to attend. The officer under unavoidable circumstances may depute another officer in his absence to receive and open tender documents on his behalf.
  - j) The **Superintending Engineer, Mahanadi South Division-I, Cuttack -cum-Member Secretary**, OSMM in the presence of the bidders or their authorized representatives, who choose to be present, will open the technical bid on **12.01.2022 at 11.30 A.M in the office of the Director, OSMM, Jobra, Cuttack.**
  - k) Statutory documents- The bidder should have EPF registration certificate, ESI registration certificate, labour license, PAN, GST and should be submitted alongwith the technical bid (Cover-I)
13. The Technical committee comprising of the Member Treasurer, Member Secretary & D.A.O., Mahanadi South Division-I, Cuttack, will scrutinize the tender documents and reserves the right to recommend for acceptance any of the bids.
14. The particulars of the proposed work given are bare minimum and must be considered only as advance information to assist the applicant.
15. Enhancement or Curtailment in the quantum of the work will not vitiate the contract.
16. The officer opening the tender documents bind himself to accept or recommend for the acceptance of the lowest tender document. In deciding the tender the manifest capability / competence of the bidder his experience in this line will be the main consideration. The Technical committee of The Odisha State Maritime Museum Trust in respect of this project will scrutinize / examine the credentials of the bidders and decide his/their capability to undertake the assignment.
17. Conditional tender are liable to be rejected.
18. Canvassing for support in any form for the acceptance of any bids is strictly prohibited.
19. If the bidder whose tender is accepted fails to deposit the performance security amount and execute the agreement documents within the notified period for any

reason whatsoever, earnest money deposited with the tender document shall be forfeited and acceptance of the bids will be cancelled.

20. The payment will be made by cheque of the Bank only. No bank commission charges on realizing such payments will be borne by the Odisha State Maritime Museum Trust.
21. Deductions of Income Tax at source shall be done as per the law. It is open to the bidders as the case may be to make an application to the Officer concerned and obtain from him a certificate authorizing the payer to deduct tax at such lower rate or deduct no tax as may be appropriate to his case. Such certificate will be valid for the period specified therein unless the officer concerned cancels it. The bidder whose tender has been accepted will have to execute the agreement in the prescribed form within 15 days of the receipt of the communication of the acceptance of his tender. He will also have to furnish the performance security amount simultaneously. Failure to do so will result in the earnest money being forfeited and his bid being cancelled.
22. All the terms and conditions of the Notice inviting Tender (NIT) and the appendices/Annexure referred to herein before will be binding on the bidders in addition to the conditions of the contract in the prescribed form.
23. Bidder should submit one affidavit at the time of submission of bid regarding authenticity of the documents submitted with the bid.
24. The qualified bidder shall deposit 1% of the Tender value as initial security deposit in shape of TDR/FDR/NSC / BG pledged in favour of Odisha State Maritime Museum Trust, Jobra, Cuttack issued by any Nationalized bank / Post Office at the time of agreement and the earnest money deposit together with initial security deposit should not be less than 2 % of the agreement value which shall be refunded back after one year of completion of work.
25. The plans specifications and scope for the work can be seen in the office of the Member Secretary, Odisha State Maritime Museum during any working days (excluding Monday)
26. All taxes, fees payable under the local rule including Income taxes & Surcharges as applicable, Octroi tax, Entry tax etc. will be borne by the contractor as admissible.

27. Request for raising and lowering the rates or dealing with any point in connection with the tender will not be considered. Conditional tenders will not be taken in to consideration.
28. **No Relation Certificate.**  
The contractor shall have to furnish certificate along with the tender to the effect that he is not related to any officer in the rank of an Assistant Engineer and above in the State P.W.D. or Under Secretary and above in the Water Resources Department., If the fact subsequently proved to be false the contract will be rescinded. The earnest money and the total security will be forfeited and shall be liable to make good the loss or damage resulting from such cancellation.
29. The tenderer whose tender is selected for acceptance shall within a period of seven days upon intimation being given to him of acceptance of his tender make an initial security deposit in the form of NSC, postal time deposit, Post Office Bank Account / Deposit Receipt of Schedule Bank, Kisan Vikas Patra and in no other form including the amount already deposited as earnest money shall be 2% of the value of the accepted tendered amount and sign agreement in the P.W.D. form No.P1 (Schedule XLV No.61) for the fulfillment of the contract in the office of the **Superintending Engineer, Mahanadi South Division-I, Cuttack, Dist-Cuttack, Odisha.**
30. **Additional performance security (APS)** is being obtained from the successful bidder when the bid amount is less than the estimated cost put to tender to the extent of exact amount of differential cost **(As detailed below)** i.e. estimated cost put to tender minus the quoted amount in shape of Term Deposit Receipt / Bank Guarantee pledged in favour of the Odisha State Maritime Museum Trust, Jobra, Cuttack / in favour of any Nationalized / Scheduled bank in India counter guaranteed by its local branch at Cuttack within seven days of issue of Letter of Acceptance (LoA) by the Superintending Engineer, Mahanadi South Division-I, Cuttack-cum-Member Secretary, OSMM, Jobra, Cuttack (by e-mail) to the successful bidder otherwise the bid of the successful bidder shall be cancelled. Further proceeding for blacklisting shall be initiated against the bidder as per Amendment to para 3.5.5 (v) of OPWD Code, Volume-I vide Works Department office Memorandum No.14459/W dated 20.09.2018.

31. The security will be refunded after **one year** on completion of the work in all respect provided the final bill is passed and will not carry any interest. Any defect noticed during the period of one year after the actual date of completion shall be rectified by the contractor at his own cost. Failure to comply such rectification the cost involved to carryout the defective work shall be met from his dues available with Department. (Ref. works Deptt order No. 17823/WE dt. 11.10.2006.
32. The security deposit together with the Initial Security money and the amount withheld according to the provision of P1 agreement shall be retained as Security for the due fulfillment of this contract. Failure to enter into the required agreement and to make the security deposit as above shall entail forfeiture of the earnest money. The written agreement to be entered into between the contractor and the Govt. shall be the foundation of the rights of both the contractor and the Govt. and the contract shall be deemed to be incomplete until the agreement has first been signed by the contractor and then by the proper officer authorized to enter into the contract on behalf of the Govt.
33. An affidavit shall be furnished by the contractor at the time of submission of tender paper about the authentication of tender documents.
34. The tender may not (at the discretion of the competent authority) be considered unless accompanied self attested true copies of the GSTIN, PAN, EPF registration certificate, ESI registration certificate, Affidavit, undertaking regarding No-relationship certificate & Bid security declaration which are mandatory.

35. Before acceptance of tender, the successful bidder will be required to submit a work programme and milestone basing on the financial achievement so as to complete the work within the stipulated time and in case of failure on the part of the agency to achieve the milestone liquidated damage will be imposed.
36. The date of commencement of work shall be as notified in work order.
37. On signing the agreement the site will be handed over to the contractor for execution and completion of works in all respect.
38. The authority reserves the right to make such increase or decrease in quantity of items of works mentioned in the scheduled attached to the tender notice as may be considered necessary for the satisfactory completion of the contract work. All such increase or decrease shall in no way invalidate/ vitiate the contract rates. The contractor shall not be entitled for any compensation on this account, except grant of extension of time where considered necessary.
39. That for the purpose of jurisdiction in the event of any dispute if any, the contract would be deemed to have been entered into within the State of Odisha and it is agreed that neither party to the contract will be competent to bring a suit in regard to the matter by this contract at any place outside the State of Odisha.
40. Under section-12 of contract labour (Regulation and Abolition Act 1970) the contractor who undertakes execution of work through labour, should produce valid license from licensing authority of labour department (labour license) to start the work.
41. The contractor shall be liable to fully indemnify the Govt. of any compensation under workmen compensation Act VII of 1993 on account of the workmen employed by the contractor and full amount of compensation paid will be recovered from the contractor. In the event of any claim sub-judice before any court of law, the claim amount shall be kept withheld till final disposal.
42. Contractor is required to abide by the fair wages clauses as introduced by Govt. of Odisha and will not pay less than the Fair wages fixed by Govt. to the labourers engaged by him for the work.

43. In case of any complaint by the labourer about the nonpayment of his wages as per latest minimum wages Act., the Trust will have the right to investigate and if the contractor is found to be in at fault, Trust may recover such amount due in any form from the contractor and pay such amount to the labourer directly under intimation to the local labour office of the Govt. The decision of the Trust is final and binding on the contractor.
44. The contractor should keep himself in touch with the S.E, MSD-I, Cuttack-Cum-Member Secretary, OSMM, Jobra, Cuttack for smooth execution of the work and arrange adequate labour depending on the workload and working space available. No claim for detention for labour on any account will be entertained.
45. No compensation will be paid by the Trust for any damage done by rain, cyclone & earthquake tide or by any other natural calamities during the execution of the work.
46. The maintenance agency will be responsible for any loss of lives of fishes and will be replaced at his cost & risk in case of any eventuality.
47. It should be understood clearly that no claim whatsoever will be entertained in regard to extra items of work or extra quantity of any item besides estimated amount, unless written order is obtained from the Trust and rates settled before the extra items of work or extra quantity of any item of work is taken up.
48. The tenderer shall have to abide by the C.P.W.D. safety code rules introduced by the Govt. of India, Ministry of Works, Housing and Supply in their standing order No.44150 dated 25.1.1957.
49. The tenderer shall bear various incidentals, sundries and contingencies necessitated by the work in full within the following or similar category.
  - (a) Rent, royalties and other charges of materials, octroi duty, entry tax & all other taxes including GST, ferry tolls, conveyance charges and other cost on account of land and buildings including temporary building and temporary electric connection to work site as well as construction of coffer dam, construction of service road, diversion road and its maintenance till completion of work required by the tenderer for collection of materials, storage housing of staff other purpose of the work. No tenderer will

however be liable to pay for temporary occupation of land owned by Govt. at the site of the work.

- (b) Labour camps or hutments including conservancy and sanitation arrangements upto the satisfaction of the local health authorities should be arranged by the contractor.
  - (c) Suitable water supply including pipe water supply wherever available for the staff and labour as well as for the work.
  - (d) Suitable equipment and wearing apparatus for the labour engaged in risky operations and medical aid to the labourer engaged for the work.
  - (e) Suitable fencing, barriers, signals including paraffin and electric signals where necessary at work and approaches in order to protect public and employees from accident.
  - (f) Compensation including cost of any suit for injury to persons or property due to neglect of any major precautions also becomes payable due to operation of the workmen compensation Act.
  - (g) The contractor has to arrange adequate lighting arrangement for the work wherever necessary at his own cost.
50. Deduction of income tax at source and surcharge on income tax will be made from each running account bill for the work at the rate as per Income Tax Act and as amended from time to time. (Present rate 2% + surcharge)
